Zoom Etiquette Recommendations

- If you join a meeting with video, please sit upright and position the view from the shoulders up and webcam at eye level.
- Remember to change your Zoom name to maintain anonymity (typically, first name and first initial of last name).
- Dress appropriately. And be mindful that your appearance and activities can be seen by others who may be cross-addicted (avoid eating, drinking alcohol, smoking, etc.).
- Please make sure if you are in a more public space to wear headphones to keep the other members' share safe and anonymous.
- Please stay muted unless you are sharing.
- If on the web, please use the Participants Window to raise your hand and vote yes or no.
- Please note the host (by Group-Conscience) has the ability and prerogative to mute callers if there is too much background noise; change a caller ID to maintain anonymity; stop participant's video and to remove a caller if there is inappropriate behavior.
- Please only view a meeting in a secluded location, keep in mind that shares are meant ONLY for members of the Fellowship of S.L.A.A.
- Do not let other members of your family in the room, as we do not allow non-members in the room during a meeting, please do not allow them in the room with 'us'.
- If you have to do other activities while a meeting is going on, please deactivate your video to keep from distracting the other members.
